

Ukrainian Holodomor Remembrance Day *November 7, 2020*

- Whereas, Eighty-seven years ago, a man-made famine known as Holodomor, killed 7 to 10 million Ukrainians from 1932-1933, innocent men, women, and children; and*
- Whereas, Holodomor was meant to punish independent-minded Ukrainians for their resistance of repressive, political, economic, and social oppression and policies; and*
- Whereas, It is important to recognize the 1932-1933 Ukrainian Holodomor as a travesty against humanity, while learning from the past to prevent similar tragedies from occurring in the future.*

Now, Therefore, I, Joe R. Zimmerman, on behalf of the members of City Council, and by the virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Sugar Land, Texas, do hereby recognize November 7, 2020 as Ukrainian Holodomor Remembrance Day in Sugar Land and urge our residents to honor its victims and educate the world about this tragic episode in our history.
